It's easy to make a referral:

- Contact us on the details below
- We'll need the date the cake is needed for, age and name of the child, any special dietary requirements, any themes of things the child likes and delivery details
- At least 2 weeks' notice is ideal to give us the highest chance of a volunteer being available, but we've turned them around much quicker, so always ask!
- We find a volunteer baker who's able to help and they'll get in touch with you or the family (as per your instructions) to arrange delivery
- The cake is baked and delivered!

It's that simple. No charges, no catches and we'll treat all referrals with complete confidentiality.

If you or your organisation are likely to make multiple referrals, we have a form you can just fill in and send to us each time.
